Dear David,

The "ChlorKing" saline chlorination systems have, after prolonged use, in two different applications at the South Lake Athletic Club, proved to be a far more effective means of water sanitization compared to conventional means of water chlorination we have used to date.

Our main outdoor swimming pool, with a capacity of 130,000 gallons, has benefited significantly since installation in January 1999 of the "ChlorKing" system. The system has had no difficulty in maintaining chlorine residuals of up to 3.00 ppm and salt levels of 7,000 ppm with 50 to 100 person bather loads and extreme outside temperatures.

Since installation, it was responsible for the removal of all forms of algae on the pool walls and floor, in addition to thereafter creating extremely clear, clean and user friendly water for bathers during the summer months up until present.

The systems installed on the whirlpools located in the men's and ladies locker room area have greatly improved the water quality visually. In addition, it had been far less aggressive to the users skin compared to the previous use (intermittent addition) of chlorine and bromine based chemicals.

Since conversation from the use of conventional chemicals, we anticipate that the "ChlorKing" systems will pay for themselves within two years. I would not hesitate in recommending the use of the "ChlorKing" system to anyone wishing to improve the quality of water for his or her guests.
